Getting to the community summit

Playford Civic Centre, 10 Playford Boulevard, Elizabeth (across from Elizabeth Shopping Centre).

There are two accessible entrances into the Civic Centre

Entrance 1 – Prince George Plaza

Entrance 2 - Playford Boulevard


There is accessible parking off Froshiber Road approx. 38 m from entrance 1.

The nearest bus stop is Stop 64B Playford Boulevard, approx. 30 m from entrance 2.

Dress code – we encourage you to wear neat casual clothes.




The view from above

They will give you a sticker with your name on it. You don't have to wear it.


The staff members will be Linley and Darci

There will be about 70 people mostly community members and a few staff and elected members.

There will be a large circle of chairs you can sit wherever you want, or you can ask for help.



The function room.

The way it will be set up will be different to the photo.

When everyone has arrived, there will be a few short introductions.

The host will introduce how it will work.

- There will be five stations around the room.
- You will work in a small group with a staff member.
- People will be moving around in small groups.
- If you feel comfortable we would love to hear your ideas.
- You will hear lots of people talking.
- All the lights will be on it may be quite bright. You can wear sunglasses inside.

You will receive a snack box about 11am which will have a wrap, muffin, cheese and crackers unless you have told us about dietary requirements. You can eat this whenever you want.

There will be tea, coffee and water. There won't be a break as you can go to the toilet or get a drink whenever you want to or have a stretch. You don't need to let anyone know when you go for a break.

There are two bathrooms and there is an accessible toilet.

They have hand dryers and paper towels.

If need help you can ask the any of the staff members.
