Tippets Bridge Road and Legoe Road, Riverlea Park.

# What We Heard Report

August 2025



# **Purpose**

This report outlines the community engagement process undertaken for the Proposed Road Closure – Tippets Bridge Road and Legoe Road, Riverlea Park. It provides the background for the proposed closure, the legislative requirements under the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991 (SA)*, and the methods used to inform and engage the community. The report also presents performance metrics to demonstrate Council's commitment to ensuring that Council decisions are informed by community input, maintaining transparency and alignment with local needs and aspirations.

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# **Executive Summary**

Council conducted a 28-day community consultation from **Monday 21 July to Saturday 17 August 2025** regarding the Proposed Road Closure – Tippets Bridge Road and Legoe Road, Riverlea Park. This process was undertaken in accordance with the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991 (SA)*.

The community were informed of the consultation in the following ways:

- Formal notification to directly affected landowners
- Public notices in The Advertiser and Government Gazette
- Information shared via Council's Engagement Hub and customer service centres
- Direct outreach to identified stakeholders.

The engagement resulted in a positive level of community awareness, demonstrated by:

- 224 page views and 184 unique visitors to the Engagement Hub project page.
- 77 document downloads indicated strong interest and information-seeking.

Despite this, no formal submissions or objections were received from the community during the consultation period.

In accordance with the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991 (SA)*, a Council report is only required if unresolved objections or easement requests are received. As neither occurred, the proposed road closure can proceed under delegation\*.

Further details on engagement activities and performance measures are provided in the full report.

\*Under delegation: In local government, delegation refers to the formal process where Council assigns certain decision-making powers to staff or designated officers. This allows routine or uncontested matters like this proposed road closure to be approved efficiently without requiring a full Council meeting or resolution.

# 1. Engagement Background and Objectives

The City of Playford proposed to close portions of Tippets Bridge Road and Legoe Road in Riverlea Park. The proposed closures will support the construction of essential stormwater infrastructure for the Riverlea Park development. This proposal is being made in line with the Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991.

The proposed road closures affecting portions of Legoe Road and Tippets Bridge Road are intended to facilitate the construction of stormwater infrastructure required for the Riverlea Park development.

As part of the drainage plan, stormwater will be diverted via the unconstructed section of Tippets Bridge Road to the formed portion of Legoe Road, then through a proposed drainage channel on adjoining land to Thompson Creek, located south of Carmelo Road, and to the designated outfall further south.

These road segments are to be repurposed as a dedicated drainage reserve, remaining under Council ownership to support long-term management. This updated approach also resolves several complexities associated with the previously approved stormwater management strategy.


To meet both legislative requirements and Council's commitment to transparency, public consultation was undertaken in accordance with the Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991 (SA), which requires South Australian councils to consult with the community when proposing to open, close, or alter a public road.

#### Our engagement level and objectives

#### Community engagement level: CONSULT

This community engagement has been identified at the consult level due to legislative requirements.

Council uses the International Association of Public Participation (IAP2) to guide Council's practice in community engagement (image below). The IAP2 Spectrum of Public Participation helps clarify the role of, and level of influence the community has in decision making.



#### **Engagement objectives:**

- To inform and raise awareness of the proposed road closure with directly affected property owners and stakeholders in accordance with the *Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991.*
- To consult with the community and relevant stakeholders on the proposal to close portions of Tippets Bridge Road and Legoe Road, Riverlea, pursuant to Section 10 of the Act.





#### 2. What we asked

The community were invited to make a submission with community consultation open over a 28-day period from **Monday 21 July until 17 August 2025.** 

## 3. How we asked it (engagement approach)

The community were informed of the consultation in the following ways:

- Formal notification (letter) to directly affected landowners.
- Direct notification to identified stakeholders.
- Public Notice in The Advertiser
- Public Notice in the Government Gazette
- Playford Council Engagement Hub
- Information made available at Council sites and Customer Contact locations -Playford Civic Centre and Stretton Centre

Community members were able to provide feedback through the following:

Feedback Options	Description
Engagement Hub	Dedicated online engagement listing provided a central location for all engagement documents, outlined timeframes, and information about how to make a submission.  It is updated at the end of the engagement process with the outcome to close the loop with our community.
Direct Email	Community members were able to make a submission via email to Council.
Phone	Council staff were available to receive phone calls and answer questions associated with the engagement.
Letters/Hard Copy	Council staff were available to receive submission via hard copy

#### 4. What we heard

#### 4.1 Overview of community engagement and performance

To ensure Council met its engagement objectives, performance was measured throughout the consultation period by tracking the number of aware, informed, and engaged community members.

The engagement resulted in a **positive level of community awareness**, demonstrated by:

- 224 page views and 184 unique visitors to Engagement Hub project page.
- 77 document downloads, indicating strong interest and information-seeking.

#### **Outcomes**

- No public submissions or objections received
- SA Water advised that easements are required over areas (A) and (B) for recycled water mains
- A public right of way may be required to connect the unmade Tippets Bridge Road with Legoe Road along the existing haul road alignment, to allow for Council access, however we are waiting on Alexander Symonds advice on this matter.

As no objections or unresolved easement requests were received, the road closure can proceed under delegation without the need for a Council report.

- Certified Survey Plan to be completed and lodged with Land Services
- Road closure confirmation to be published in the Government Gazette
- Certificates of Title issued to Council

The City of Playford proposes to close and retain a portion of Legge Road and Tippetts.

Bridge Road at the intersection of Tippets Bridge Road and Legge Road shown lettered and delineated on the accompanying preliminary plan and described in the copy of the advertised public notice.

A copy of the preliminary plan is available for public inspection at the Council office 12 Bishopstone Road <u>Qayoren</u> Park, or at the office of the Surveyor-General at Level 10, 83 Pirie Street Adelaide during normal office hours. The Preliminary Plan can also be viewed at <u>www.sa.gov.au/roadsactproposals</u>.

Any person affected by the proposed closure is entitled to object or to apply for an easement to be granted in that persons favour over the subject land.

The objection or application for an easement must set out in full the (name and address) of the person making the submission.

All submissions must give full details of the nature and location of the desired easements and extent to which other land is affected. Written submissions must be made to the Council office at 12 Bishopstone Road <u>Davoren</u> Park SA 5113 and to the Office of the Surveyor-General at PO Box 1815 Adelaide SA 5001 and be served within 28 days of the date of the last publication of the public notice, otherwise it is not valid. If it is desired to support any submission personally or by representation you should advise Council accordingly and you will be advised if a meeting is required to consider such submissions.

Once a decision is made by the said Council to either make the Road Process Order, vary the proposal or discontinue the matter, any person who made a submission will be notified accordingly by Council.
